Offense: Possession of a Controlled Substance

Date: 01.02.17

Time: 0415 hours

Location: 200 blk West Bitters Road

An officer was traveling westbound in the 300 Blk of W. Bitters Rd, when he observed a vehicle traveling eastbound at a high rate of speed. The officer clocked the vehicle going 54 mph in a clearly marked 40 mph zone. The officer conducted a traffic stop. The vehicle came to a complete stop in the 200 Blk of W. Bitters Rd. The officer made contact with the driver of the vehicle. When making contact the officer detected a strong odor of marijuana coming from the driver. The officer asked for his Driver's License and insurance. The officer requested for additional units to his location for extra cover. While waiting for additional units to arrive the officer asked the driver if he was on parole or probation. The driver said he was on parole for possession of narcotics. The driver became nervous and continued to make furtive movements with his hands while inside the vehicle. Once another officer arrived, the driver was asked to step out of the vehicle. When the driver exited the vehicle and opened the door, the odor of marijuana became stronger. The officer conducted a search of the area where the driver was sitting and discovered a clear plastic bag with a green leafy substance (Marijuana) in the center console. The officer then walked over to the driver and placed him under arrest for possession of marijuana. While conducting the vehicle inventory the officer found several assorted pills. Some were identified and they will all be lab tested. The driver was booked on the marijuana and the pills.

A male reported he had gone into a fast food restaurant for 5 minutes. When he went back outside, he saw that his passenger window had been broken. He immediately noticed that his computer bag was missing. The bag contained a laptop computer, \$200 dollars in cash, a \$100 gift card and assorted paperwork. The officer inspected the vehicle and area of the burglary. It appears the suspect(s) simply smashed the window and grabbed the satchel off the front seat.
