Officers were dispatched to a residence to check on a suspicious person. According to the homeowner, she had received a call from Amazon asking permission to leave a package inside her front security gate. The resident said she had never received a call from Amazon asking this information and was worried it may be someone attempting to burglarize her residence. Upon arrival, the officers found the service gate was closed, but unlocked. The officers opened the gate and began to check the exterior of the residence. While on routine patrol, an officer observed two storage unit doors open. The doors were open and several items were outside of the units. Officers conducted a perimeter search of the storage and tried to make contact with the property manager. Officers found a chain link fence had been cut to gain entry to the property. The storage unit's locks had been broken. It would be unknown what was taken until the storage unit renters could be contacted.
