Offense: Indecent Exposure

An officer was contacted by dispatch about lewd conducted at a local business. The officer made contact with the female caller who informed him that an unknown male was sexually gratifying himself (Masturbating) while she was cleaning the store. The officer asked the female about the smell. The female informed the officer that her boyfriend smokes inside the vehicle sometimes. A search of the vehicle was conducted. While searching the vehicle, the officer located a green leafy substance in a clear plastic bag, located in a back pack on the passenger seat. Also found was a black digital scale in the center console. The green leafy substance was inside an apron cloth from the restaurant that the female works at. The female admitted to the backpack being hers. When told about the marijuana being found, the female stated "I forgot it was there". The vehicle was released to the owner when he arrived. The female was booked into jail.

An officer received a call on the city cell phone regarding a suspicious male at a local restaurant. The manager of the store stated that a male wearing a trench coat and red beanie was sitting on the patio of the business and she felt uneasy about him. Two officers arrived at the location and walked around the businesses. Officers observed the male sitting on the patio, listening to music and enjoying his drink. No contact was made with the subject. The officers resumed patrol.
