Offense: Wanted Person

An officer observed a vehicle traveling at 53mph in a 40mph zone. The vehicle was stopped and the driver was identified by his Texas ID card. A computer check showed the driver had two active warrants with the city of San Antonio Municipal Court. The warrants were confirmed and the driver was arrested on the active warrants.

The owner informed me that the HD Video/ Audio Cable cost approximately \$500 and the Labor to replace the cable cost approximately \$750.
