### **Offense: Unauthorized Use Motor Vehicle**

**Location: 200 Blk. Hill Country Lane**

A resident in the 200 block of Hill Country Lane contacted the police department to report their car was taken from their residence. An officer arrived and contacted the resident, who advised they had parked their vehicle in front of their house the previous night. The vehicle was left unlocked with the keys inside the vehicle. Sometime during the night, an unknown individual entered the property and took the vehicle without the consent of the owner. The officer completed a police report and notified dispatch of the stolen vehicle. Dispatch entered the vehicle as stolen. This report was sent to the Criminal Investigations Division for follow up.

A resident in the 100 block of Cabin Path called for police officer to make his location for a burglary report. Upon the officer's arrival, the resident stated sometime overnight, and unknown person had entered into their vehicle and taken several items. The resident provided descriptions of items them items taken. The resident also advised there was property left inside the vehicle that did not belong to them. The resident believed the property must have belonged to the suspect that stole their items.

At a later date and time, Mathis Police Department observed an individual spray painting a vehicle.
