Offense: Narcotic Laws

An officer stopped a vehicle for speeding on Bitters Road. The driver stopped their vehicle in a parking lot in the 80 block of West Bitters Rd. As the officer approached the vehicle, a strong odor of marijuana was detected coming from inside the vehicle. The officer asked the driver if there was any marijuana inside the vehicle, to which they said no. The officer obtained an identification and insurance from the driver and asked a second time if there was any marijuana inside the vehicle. This time, the driver said yes, they had some. The driver handed the officer a metal grinder containing several marijuana buds. The officer called for a cover unit and had the driver and passenger exit the vehicle. While searching the vehicle, several bongs and glass smoking pipes were discovered. Also discovered was a partially full bottle of Tito's vodka. Due to the contraband in the vehicle, the driver and passenger were issued Hill Country Village citations. Each occupant called for a ride, at which point they were released. A case for possession of marijuana was prepared and sent to CID to file at large.

At this time, the driver sped away, running stop signs, red lights, speeding, and driving on the shoulders of the roadways. The officer determined the risk was too great to pursue the vehicle and terminated the pursuit. A case was prepared for Evading Arrest – Motor Vehicle, which was sent to CID for follow up investigation.
