Calls of Interest

Offense: Driving While Intoxicated

Date: 10.08.17

Time: 0201 hours

Location: 15300 Blk. San Pedro

An Officer was monitoring the traffic light located at Brook Hollow Blvd. and San Pedro Ave. While doing this, the officer observed vehicle approach the lights and screech to a stop in the middle of the intersection. When the traffic light turned green, the same vehicle screeched its tires and turned. The officer conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle due to the observations listed above. Upon contact with the driver, the Officer observed signs that the driver could be intoxicated. The driver completed Standardized Field Sobriety tests, which confirmed the Officer's suspicion of Driving While Intoxicated. The driver was arrested and subsequently transported to a local hospital as the driver was complaining about shoulder and arm pains. Upon a medical clearance, the driver was transported to 401 South Frio. Due to the amount of time that passed from the time of stop and arrival time at the Jail, this case will be filled at large. No further action taken.

Offense: Wanted Person

Date: 10.08.17

Time: 1545 hours

Location: 200 Blk. W. Bitters Rd.

An Officer conducted a traffic stop in the 200 block of West Bitters Road. The traffic stop was initiated due to the high rate of speed at which the listed vehicle was travelling. Moving radar showed the listed vehicle to be travelling at 58 miles per hour in a 40 mile per hour zone. During the traffic stop, an NCIC/TCIC check of the vehicle license plate returned (2) City of San

Antonio warrants associated with the vehicle. This officer made contact with the driver of the vehicle and obtained a driver's license. An NCIC/TCIC check of the license also returned (1) warrant from Bexar County for failure to appear at trial for a misdemeanor drug possession charge. The driver was arrested and booked on the active warrants.

Offense: Driving While Intoxicated

Location: 300 Blk. W. Bitters Rd.

While conducting a business check, and Officer observed a vehicle pass with smoke and sparks coming from under the vehicle. The Officer stopped the vehicle in the 300 block of West Bitters Road, where it was determined the vehicle did not have a tire on the front passenger side of the vehicle. The Officer contacted the driver, who was unaware of the missing tire. While speaking to the driver, the Officer detected a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the driver. The driver was removed from the vehicle completed Standardized Field Sobriety Testing. Upon the results, the officer placed the driver under arrest for Driving While Intoxicated. The driver was transported to 401 S. Frio and booked.

Offense: Possession of Control Substance

Date: 10.12.17

Time: 1754 hours

Location: 13700 Blk. San Pedro

An Officer observed a vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed in the 13800 Blk. of San Pedro Ave. The vehicle speed was clocked, using Lidar, traveling 60 MPH in a clearly marked 45 MPH zone. The Officer stopped the vehicle in the parking lot of a local business located in the 13700 Blk. of San Pedro. Contact with the driver of the vehicle. The driver provided a driver's license and insurance. A computer check of the driver and the vehicle through NCIC/TCIC came back with the vehicle showing Unconfirmed Insurance and the driver with a Not Eligible DL. The driver showed an active suspension due to default on instalment. The Officer called the insurance company to verify the driver's policy, but was informed by the auto agent that the policy for the vehicle has been canceled. The Officer informed the driver of the situation and asked them to step out of the vehicle. Once outside the vehicle the Officer explained that the vehicle would be impounded for an ineligible driver's license and no insurance. The driver was also informed that they would be receiving a few citations for traffic violations. Dispatch was notified of the situation and the Officer ordered Texas Towing to the location. A vehicle inventory of the vehicle, prior to impoundment, discovered a green leafy substance in a clear plastic bag in the center console. Based on the Officer's training and experience, the substance was believed to be marijuana. The driver was placed under arrest and handcuffed. The driver was secured in the back of the Officer's patrol vehicle and read (Miranda) rights, which they stated they understood. The Officer returned to vehicle inventory and discovered a digital scale in between the driver's seat and the floorboard along with 4 yellowish pills, which the Officer believed to be Xanax, in the center console. The driver was asked about the pills and marijuana, which he replied that he knew about the marijuana being in the center console but was unaware of the pills. The vehicle was impounded and released to Texas Towing for removal and safe

keeping. Texas Towing departed location with the vehicle at which time the Officer relocated to the Police Station to complete the rest of the processing. The evidence was secured in the property room. The driver was issued three HCV Municipal Court Summons for the traffic violations. Upon signing for the citations, the driver was transported to 401 S. Frio and booked for Possession of CS PG 3 less Than 28 Grams, and Possession of Marijuana 0-2 oz.
