Offense: Burglary of Vehicle

Date: 11.01.17

Time: 0539 hours

Location: 13800 Blk. San Pedro

An Officer was dispatched to a local business in the 13800 block of San Pedro Ave. for a Burglary of Vehicle report. The Officer arrived at the location and made contact with Victim, who informed the Officer that their vehicle was broken into in the early morning hours. The Victim said that a vehicle drove into the parking lot of the business at 0539hrs, as seen on surveillance video. The alarm to the Victim's truck alerted at 0543 hrs. The Victim went outside and discovered their vehicle had been burglarized. When the Victim checked the vehicle, they discovered the passenger door was open and that their Oxygen/Acetylene Torch was missing. The Victim estimated that the torch cost between \$300 and \$400. The Victim completed an HCV Property Loss Report and an Intent to Prosecute Form. The business manager downloaded the surveillance video of the incident, which was forwarded to CID for further investigation.

Offense: Wanted Person

Location: 400 Blk. W. Bitters Road

An Officer was traveling on West Bitters Road and observed a white Mazda 3 weaving within a lane. As the Officer switched lanes to get behind the white Mazda 3, the vehicle immediately pulled into a driveway in the 400 block of West Bitters Road. As the Officer exited the patrol unit to make contact, the driver exited the vehicle and ran to the passenger side of the vehicle.

The passenger slid across the front seat into the driver's seat. The Officer instructed both occupants to exit the vehicle and remain outside the vehicle. Upon making contact with driver, the Officer detected the odor of an alcoholic beverages. Both occupants were identified and their information was checked for active warrants. The computer return on the driver showed six warrants for their arrest. As cover officers arrived on scene to assist, the driver was placed under arrest for the outstanding warrants. The passenger called for a ride from the location. The driver was transported to the San Antonio Magistrates Office where they were booked on the active warrants.

Offense: Crash

Location: 13800 Blk. San Pedro

An Officer was dispatched to a local business located in the 13800 block of San Pedro Avenue for a minor crash with no injuries. Upon the Officer's arrival, contact was made with the complainant who stated their vehicle was hit on the rear right panel while they were inside the business. The Officer observed paint on the left rear panel that appeared to be from another vehicle. The complainant stated there was a green truck parked to the right of their car, but the vehicle had left prior to the Officer's arrival. A second Officer made contact with the manager of the business and was able to obtain video surveillance of the green truck hitting the complainant's vehicle. The second Officer was also able to obtain the contact information for the operator of the green truck. Officer's made contact with the operator of the green truck, who stated they did not know that their truck had struck the other vehicle. This driver told Officer's they would return and give their information. Upon this driver's arrival, information was obtained and passed on to the complainant.
