Upon returning to their vehicle, they discovered a pink back pack that had been left in their vehicle was missing. The complainant stated there was no forced entry into the vehicle and they believed the vehicle was left unlocked. The responding Officer checked the area, but was unable to locate the property or suspect. This case will be forwarded to the Criminal Investigations Division.

A Resident called the Patrol Cell phone to report an individual opening mailboxes and talking mail. Officers responded to the area and were able to stop a vehicle matching the description provided by the Resident. The driver of the vehicle did not have a license to operate a motor vehicle, so the vehicle was impounded. While conducting an Inventory of the property inside the vehicle, several pieces of mail, including mail from Hill Country Village, licenses, credit cards, and other personal forms of identification issued to individuals not inside the vehicle were discovered. Officer's also observed the steering column appeared to have been tampered with, leading Officer's to believe the truck was stolen. Computer returns from dispatch relayed that the passenger of the vehicle had an active warrant for possession of dangerous drugs. The truck

did come back stolen as well. The driver and the passenger were both arrested and charged with multiple felony offenses. This case will be forwarded to the Criminal Investigations Division.

Officers were dispatched to a possible suicidal individual at a local business located in the 15600 block of San Pedro. Upon the Officers arrival, the manager of the business stated that a customer had come into the business and made comments that lead the manager to believe the customer was a threat to themselves. Officers were able to obtain identification and a phone number for the customer, at which time an Officer contacted the individual over the phone. The Officer was able to confirm that the individual was suicidal and in need of immediate intervention. The Officer notified San Antonio Police and requested they respond to the individual's residence to check on the welfare. The Officer was also able to reach a child of the individual, who also went to the individual's house to check on them. Upon the child's arrival, the suicidal subject was okay. The child assumed responsibility to care for the subject.
