**Offense: Violation State Vehicle Laws**

**Date: 11.14.17**

**Location: 14100 Blk. San Pedro**

An Officer stopped a motorist for displaying an expired registration sticker in the 14100 block of San Pedro Avenue. The Officer contacted the driver and explained the nature of the traffic stop. The Officer asked the driver for their license and insurance. The Officer conducted a computer check of the license, which showed a Not Eligible status for the driver. The return also showed the driver's license was Denied Renewal. As a result of the license status, the driver was issued a citation and contacted a license driver to pick them and the vehicle up.

**Offense: Narcotic Possession**

**Location: 14000 Blk. San Pedro**

An Officer conducted a traffic stop in the 14000 block of San Pedro Avenue for driving with no lights on the rear of the vehicle. The driver of the vehicle stated they realized they were driving with only on the vehicle after they were stopped. As the Officer was gathering information from the driver, a heavy odor of marijuana was detected coming from the vehicle. The Officer instructed the driver to exit the vehicle and stand near the rear of the vehicle. When asked about the marijuana smell, the driver admitted there was marijuana in the vehicle. The driver was placed in handcuffs and temporarily detained pending further investigation. Inside the vehicle, the Officer discovered a glass jar with three packages of green leafy substance inside a black backpack, a black metal grinder with green leafy substance, and a plastic bottle used as drug

paraphernalia to smoke out of. At this time, the driver was placed under arrest for Possession of Marijuana < 2 Oz. At the police department, the green leafy substance weighed 5.5 grams and tested positive with a Nark II field test kit #NARK2005 for marijuana. A black backpack with a tablet was collected from the vehicle to be safeguarded as property. The green leafy substance was logged and bagged as evidence.

**Offense: Burglary of Vehicle**

**Location: 15800 Blk. San Pedro**

On 11-15-17 at 1655 hours, an Officer was dispatched to a local business in the 15800 block of San Pedro Ave. The caller requested assistance with filing a burglary report. The Officer made the location and made contact with the caller, who advised that on 11-08-17 at approximately 1845 hours, an unknown person in a black Dodge Ram pulled into the parking lot and burglarized their work vehicle. The caller stated all the missing items were located in bed of the work truck. The caller also advised that they did not notice any items missing until 11-15-17. An employee of the local business reviewed the surveillance footage and discovered the incident. The employee provided a copy of the surveillance footage to the Officer for investigation. The caller provided a list of the items taken and filled out a Witness Information Card and Intent to Prosecute form. The caller advised that they did not give anybody permission to taken any items out of the vehicle. A case number was provided to the caller.
