Offense: Fire Call

Location: 14600 Blk. San Pedro

On 11-20-17 at 0855 hours, an Officer was dispatched to a vehicle fire in the 14600 block of San Pedro. Dispatch notes advised that a vehicle parked at a local business had caught on fire. The Officer made the location and located the vehicle on fire. San Antonio Fire Department made location and extinguished the fire. The vehicle was towed from the business and the Officer returned to service.

An Officer attempted to stop a vehicle for speeding in the 500 block of West Bitters Road. The driver pulled into a local business in an attempt to stop for the Officer, but as soon as the Officer began to exit the patrol unit, the violator sped off. A brief pursuit transpired before the violator crashed the car into a telephone pole at South Tower Drive and West Bitters Road. While conducting an inventory of the violator's vehicle, the Officer discovered narcotics and narcotic paraphernalia. The violator was placed under arrest for the evading and narcotic charges.

Officers were dispatched to a local business in the 14600 block of San Pedro to assist with a subject who appeared to be suffering from dementia. Upon the Officers arrival, contact was made with the subject. The subject was disoriented and confused. Officers attempted to locate a care taker for the individual, but were unable to locate one. Officers attempted to driver the individual home, but the individual could only remember their old work address. Due to the individual's mental state and the inability to locate a care taker, the individual was transported to a local hospital for observation and possible treatment.

Offense: Driving While Intoxicated

Location: 15300 Blk. San Pedro

While conducting a business patrol in the 15300 block of San Pedro, an Officer observed a vehicle parked in the middle of the access road with the engine running. The Officer pulled behind the vehicle and activated the overhead lights of the patrol unit. The Officer attempted to make contact with the driver, but the driver was passed out behind the wheel. The Officer requested additional units for assistance. Upon the arrival of additional units, Officers were able to wake the driver up. As soon as the driver door was opened, Officer's detected a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the driver and sole occupant of the vehicle. The driver was walked to the parking lot of a nearby local business where they were given a Standardized Field Sobriety Text. Based on the driver's actions and the results of the test, the Officer placed the driver under arrest for Driving While Intoxicated. The vehicle was towed from the location. The driver was transported to the Magistrate's officer for booking. The driver refused to provide a breath test, so a blood warrant was obtained. Upon a Judge's aligning of the warrant, a blood sample was collected from the driver.
