**Offense: Assault / Family Violence**

**Details: An HCVPD Officer observed a vehicle pull into above location and both a male and female get out and start to assault each other. The male punched the female in the eye and causes injury. Officer contacted the couple and through his investigation, decided to arrest the male for assault / family violence. The female was released at the scene however the case will be reviewed by CID for any further charges to be filed.**

He checked with the owners and they did not see anything. This case will be followed up by the CID unit.**

**Details: A HCVPD Officer was stopped at the service station and observed three suspects acting suspicious near a vehicle. The suspects got into their vehicle when they saw the police officer. The officer checked the license plate and it showed to be a stolen vehicle. The officer followed the vehicle out of the location and let the dispatch know what was happening. He turned his emergency lights on and pursued the vehicle north on San Pedro and then onto Redland Rd where the officer lost the vehicle. This case will be turned over to the CID unit to follow up on the case.**
