The male subject requested medical attention due to smoke inhalation. The San Antonio Fire Department made location, assessed the scene, and provided medical attention to the male subject. The tow company advised that two tow trucks were being dispatched to location, one for the burnt unit and one for the resident's vehicle. The resident advised that the vehicle caught fire inside the cab and that male extinguished the fire by using the water hose.
