

**AN ORDINANCE CANCELING THE MAY 5, 2018
GENERAL ELECTION FOR THE CITY OF HILL
COUNTRY VILLAGE AND DECLARING EACH
UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE ELECTED TO OFFICE**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Hill Country Village called a General Election to be held on May 5, 2018 for the purpose of electing Mayor and Council Members to City Council Place Two (2), Three (3) and Four (4).


WHEREAS, at the close of the official filing period the candidates were unopposed and no applications for write-in candidacy have been filed as of now for said positions; and

WHEREAS, Texas Election Code, Subchapter C, Election of Unopposed Candidates, Sections 2.051 through 2.053, allows for the cancellation of an election where candidates are unopposed and further allows that by ordinance the City Council may declare each unopposed candidate elected to office;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HILL COUNTRY VILLAGE, TEXAS that the May 5, 2018 General Election for the City of Hill Country Village, Texas for the purpose of electing Mayor and City Council Members to City Council Place 2, 3 and 4 be canceled and each of the following unopposed candidates is declared elected to the office listed and shall be issued certificates of election following the time the election results should have been canvassed.
