

A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE CITY OF HILL COUNTRY VILLAGE TO APPLY FOR AND IF APPROVED ACCEPT A CRIMINAL JUSTICE PROGRAM FY 2020 GRANT FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONVERSION TO THE NATIONAL INCIDENT-BASED REPORTING (NIBRS) PROGRAM, FROM THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, The City of Hill Country Village finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Hill Country Village, Hill Country Village, Texas that the Texas Conversion to the National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) Program be operated for the FY2020; and

WHEREAS, The City of Hill Country Village City Council agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office, Criminal Justice Division grant application; and

WHEREAS, The City of Hill Country Village City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, The City of Hill Country Village City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

WHEREAS, The City of Hill Country Village City Council designates Frank Morales, Chief of Police as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that The City of Hill Country Village City Council approves submission of the grant application for the Texas Conversion to the National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) Program, FY2020 to the Office of the Governor.
