Offense: Burglary of Vehicle

Details: A HCVPD Officer received a call for a Burglary of Vehicle at the above location. Some unknown suspect broke into the complainant's vehicle and without effective consent, took several personal items totaling over \$50,000. The complainant stated that he locked the vehicle but there was no damage to the door or window. CID is following up on the case.

Details: A HCVPD Officer was checking on businesses in the above area and observed a damage glass window with a bullet hole in it. The window was still intact and no entry was made into the store. Case is being followed up on by CID.

Details: HCVPD Officer was dispatched the above location for a Business Alarm. Once Officers arrived at location they found a broken door in the front and store merchandise on the outside. Some unknown person broke out the door with some type of crow bar and entered the store. The suspect then grabbed as much clothes as he could and ran out the back door dropping some items. Suspect got into a newer model Dodge Ram truck and fled the scene. Case turned over to the CID Unit.
