**Offense: Recovered Stolen Vehicle**

Officers did not see any suspects but there was a video of the incident. Also, fingerprints were obtained from the vehicle. The incident will be investigated by the CID unit.

**Details:** HCVPD Officer received a call on the patrol cell phone. The caller stated that there was a broken glass window at the above location. Upon arriving at the location, the Officer contacted the property manager who showed the officer the broken window. It appears that an Unknown person attempted to break into the business but was unable to break both glass in the double pane window. The suspect then left the area. CID went to the location and attempted to lift fingerprints. There was video of the suspect. CID will follow up on the case.
