### **Calls of Interest**

**Offense: Burglary of Vehicle**

**Details:** A HCVPD Officer was dispatched to the 118 Village Circle for a burglary of vehicle. Officers arrived at location making contact with the complainant who informed the officers that their vehicle had been burglarized. Complainant said an unknown subject entered their vehicle without their consent. Entry into the vehicle was made by punching the locking mechanism. Once inside the vehicle all the contents inside the vehicle were rummaged through, it is unknown if any items were taken. The incident will be investigated by the CID unit.

**Offense: Burglary of Habitation**

**Details:** A HCVPD Officer was dispatched to the 402 Tower Drive for a burglary of habitation. The Officer arrived on location and contacted the complainant who informed the officer they were an employee of the homeowner. Complainant said once he arrived at location for work he noticed the garage door to be open and a vehicle to be missing from location. Complainant said there were some personal item taken which belonged to him such as several power tools and a laptop computer. No signs of forced entry was located and no usable finger prints were able to be lifted. Crime scene area was photographed. The incident will be investigated by the CID unit.
