Offense: Narcotic Paraphernalia

Location: 300 Blk. W. Bitters Rd.

Details: A HCVPD Officer was conducting traffic control in the 300 Blk. of W. Bitters and noticed a motor vehicle traveling faster than the posted speed limit for the area. The Officer was able to verify the vehicle speed to be traveling over the posted speed limit. The Officer conducted a traffic stop on said vehicle at which time a secondary unit was called out to assist. The Secondary officer made contact with the driver of the vehicle, and while making contact with the driver, the officer smelled a strong and pungent odor of marijuana emitting from inside the vehicle. Due to having probable cause the officer conducted a vehicle search and located a green leafy substance (marijuana) inside the vehicle. The marijuana was seized, and the driver was issued a Hill Country Village Court Summons and was released without incident. The officer inventoried the marijuana and placed it in the property locker to be destroyed. The incident will be forwarded to investigations for proper disposal of the marijuana.

The Officer made contact with the complainant who stated that one of their co-workers assaulted him. The Complainant stated that he was sprayed with a liquid chemical (Break Clean) on the arm and torso which caused significant pain. The Complainant also stated, the co-worker reached into their pocket and produced a lighter and at which time raised the liquid chemical (Brake Clean) and pointed it in their direction in a manner in which made the complainant fear for his safety. The Complainant stated they did believe their co-worker was going to light them on fire. The incident will be investigated by the CID unit.
