Offense: Driving while Intoxicate

Details: An HCV Officer received a call for service in the 15700 block of San Pedro for a car that was parked in the middle of the roadway. Upon making contact with the female driver, the officer noticed her to be slumped over and asleep with the vehicle running and still in gear. When the officer spoke with the driver, he could smell a moderate odor of metabolized alcohol emanating from the inside of the vehicle. The officer asked the driver to step out of the vehicle at which time the officer administered the Standardized Field Sobriety Test (SFST) to ensure that the driver was fit to drive. Upon completion of the (SFST) the driver was found to be unfit to drive a motor vehicle and was taken into custody for Driving While Intoxicated. Details: An HCV Officer conducted a traffic stop for a traffic violation. Upon making contact with the driver, the officer could smell a strong odor of marijuana emanating from the inside of the vehicle. Due to having probable cause, the officer conducted a search of the driver's vehicle. During the search, the officer located a numerous amount of small baggies with a white powdery substance inside. The officer also found a green leafy substance inside of a black and yellow backpack. The officer took possession of the narcotics and the driver was released, pending charges for the narcotics.
