Details: An HCV Officer received a call for service in the 15800 block of San Pedro for a Theft that occurred at this location. Once the Officer arrived, they made contact with the complainant who stated they received a call from the property manager who informed their storage unit had been damaged. Complainant informed the officer, someone entered their storage and removed some items from their storage unit without their consent. Details: An HCV Officer received a call for service in the 13600 block of San Pedro for a car that was parked in the middle of the roadway. Upon making contact with the male driver, the officer noticed the male to be sitting in the car unaware of his surroundings. When the officer spoke with the driver, he could smell a moderate odor of metabolized alcohol emanating from the inside of the vehicle. The officer asked the driver to step out of the vehicle at which time the officer administered the Standardized Field Sobriety Test (SFST) to ensure that the driver was fit to drive. Upon completion of the (SFST) the driver was found to be unfit to drive a motor vehicle and was taken into custody for Driving While Intoxicated.
