A public hearing, discussion and possible action regarding an application for a zoning district change for the property located at 13627 San Pedro Avenue, Hill Country Village, Texas 78232, Legal Description CB 5833E Blk Lot 184A & 185C, City of Hill Country Village, from Residential "R-1" to Business/Office "B-4" as submitted by Mr. Michael Bravo, the current property owner.
