1. Call to Order.

Chairman Lonnie Wulfe called the meeting to order at 6:53 p.m.

2. Discussion and possible action regarding approval of the meeting minutes of December 29, 2025.

Mr. Doug Boom motioned to approve the minutes as presented. Mr. Robert Myers seconded the motion. The motion was passed unanimously.

3. Citizens to be heard.

At this time, citizens who have filled out a registration form prior to the start of the meeting may speak on any topic they wish to bring to the attention of the Board of Adjustment so long as that topic is not on the agenda for this meeting. Citizens may speak on specific agenda items when that item is called for discussion. During the Citizens to be Heard section no Board action may take place and no Board discussion or response is required to the speaker. However, the Board Chair or the City Administrator may make a statement of specific factual information in response to an inquiry or recite existing policy in response to an inquiry. A time limit of two minutes per speaker is permitted; the Board may extend this time at their discretion.

4. A public hearing, discussion and possible action regarding a request from Mr. John McNair for variance of a side setback of 7 ft to the Zoning Code, Chapter 78, Section 78-16 (B)(5)(A) which requires a side setback of 25 feet for the property located at 114 Cherokee Lane, City of Hill Country Village, Texas 78232 in the R-1 Zoning District and legally described as CB 5833A BLK 4 LOT 108 in Bexar County.

Chairman Lonnie Wulfe opened the public hearing at 6:54 p.m.

Mr. John McNair presented his hardship of drainage, elevation, and historical trees for the variance request.

Mr. Lonnie Wulfe read the letters that were received from residents within 750 feet.

W.S. & L.D. Von Behren 209 Tower, against approval of variance, too close to the property line, pickle courts are extremely loud, 70-80 decibels.

Amy & Brian Beck, 117 Cherokee Lane, for approval of variance, no problem with variance request, awesome, considerate neighbors.

Gary Joeris, 118 Cherokee Lane, is against the approval of the variance.

John Stoll, 110 Cherokee Lane, verbal approval for variance.

Chairman Lonnie Wulfe closed the public hearing at 7:02 p.m.

Chairman Lonnie Wulfe motioned for a recess at 7:02 p.m. and back in session at 7:03 p.m.

Mr. Doug Boom motioned to approve the variance, and Mr. Robert Myers seconded the motion.

Motion passed unanimously.

No report presented.


6. Adjourn.


