### **Calls of Interest**

**Incident: Burglary of a Building**

**Time: 4:59am**

**Location: 15721 San Pedro Ave (Goldmasters)**

**Details:** Hill Country Village officer received a call for a business alarm activation. Upon arrival HCV officer observed the front door of the business was shattered. When back up arrived HCV officer cleared the building. No suspects were located inside. HCV officer collected all evidence found at the scene. The case was forwarded to HCV Criminal Investigations Department for investigation.

HCV officers checked the house as well and did not see any signs of criminal activity at the residence. While HCV officer were checking outside the residence the officers observed a vehicle drive by and it appeared that when turning on the street the headlights would go across the front of the residence likely causing the light to appear at the bottom of the door.

HCV officer took over CPR until SAFD EMS arrived on scene and took over. After multiple lifesaving attempts the male subject was unable to be revived.
