Incident: EMS Call

Date: 06/04/2026

Time: 9:18am

Location: 117 Village Circle

Details: Hill Country Village officer received a call via the city patrol phone for a lift assist at 117 Village Circle. Upon arrival the HCV officer observed a male subject lying on the bed. Unaware if the subject fell on the floor and picked himself up to the bed or fell on the bed the HCV officer advised the male subject to stay lying down until SAFD and EMS arrived to assess him. It was determined that the male subject be taken to the hospital for further evaluation.

Incident: Warrant Arrest

Location: 200 Block W Bitters Rd

Details: While in a yield lane of San Pedro Avenue waiting to make a right turn on W Bitters, a Hill Country Village officer observed a vehicle with a defective brake light. The HCV officer then conducted a traffic stop. While conducting his traffic stop investigation the HCV officer found the driver to have an active warrant out of Bexar County for a DWI. The officer then placed the driver in custody and confirmed the warrant. Once the warrant was confirmed the driver was taken to Bexar County Detention Center.

Incident: Disturbance

Details: A HCV officer was dispatched to McDonald's for a verbal disturbance in progress. Upon arrival the HCV officer observed a female who was visibly upset. While speaking with the female subject she stated her boyfriend was being hysterical and wanted to go home without her boyfriend. The male subject then stepped out of the car and walked to the back and stated he was leaving. No offense occurred.

Incident: Suspicious Person**Date: 06/11/2026****Time: 12:13am****Location: 15083 San Pedro Ave (Iron Ridge Apartment)**

Details: HCV officer was dispatched to the location for an unknown individual swimming in the swimming pool after hours. Upon arrival HCV officer searched the pool but did not see an individual swimming. The HCV officer drove around the complex looking for an individual that appeared wet from swimming. The HCV officer was unable to locate the subject. No criminal offense occurred.

Incident: EMS Call**Date: 06/14/2026****Time: 10:39pm****Location: 15715 San Pedro Ave (McDonald's)**

Details: HCV officer was dispatched to the location for a report of a male subject having a medical episode and was unresponsive. Upon arrival the HCV officer observed the male subject lying on the ground with a female subject checking him for a pulse. HCV officer asked the male subjects' friend what happened. His friend stated he didn't know what happened, when his friend got out of the truck he noticed his legs giving out and then his friend fell to the ground. When SAFD and EMS arrived they gave the subject Narcan, soon after the subject was given Narcan he was responsive. The male subject was then released under the care of his friend.

Incident: EMS Call**Date: 06/25/2026****Time: 5:03pm****Location: 214 Tomahawk Trail**

Details: HCV officer was dispatched to the location for a male subject having trouble breathing after choking on food. Upon arrival HCV officer made contact with the resident who led him to the male subject that was choking. HCV officer observed another male subject performing CPR on the unresponsive subject. HCV officer took over CPR until SAFD EMS arrived on scene and took over. After multiple lifesaving attempts the male subject was unable to be revived.
